Purpose

The purpose of the workshop is to engage children and teenagers in interactive way on the topics of climate, equality & peace, based on the “Leonardo 4 Children” 2022 competitions across Europe.

The purpose of the concert & award ceremony is to celebrate the winners of the “Leonardo 4 Children”, to promote young music talents and to raise funds in favour of beneficiary project in cooperation with UNICEF.

Beneficiary project

The funds raised at the event and via the tickets will be fully used for the support of education and social integration of Ukrainian children via UNICEF, to help them overcome the post-traumatic stress of the war and the displacement.



The past eight years of conflict in Ukraine have inflicted profound and lasting harm on children, and the escalation of the conflict at the end of February is having a devastating impact on the country’s 7.5 million children.

Children continue to be killed, wounded and deeply traumatized by the violence all around them. One month into the war, 4.3 million children have been displaced, one of the fastest large-scale displacements of children since World War II.

UNICEF is working with partners to reach vulnerable children and families with essential services – including health, education, protection, water and sanitation – as well as life-saving supplies; in Ukraine and in neighboring countries.

UNICEF’s efforts include:

- Ramping up efforts to meet critical and escalating needs for safe water, health care, education and protection.
- Delivering family hygiene kits, baby diapers, maternal health kits, institutional hygiene kits, disinfectants and bottled water to health and social institutions in eastern Ukraine.
- Increasing the number of mobile child protection teams working between conflict lines.

- Working with UNHCR and partners to activate Blue Dot hubs – one-stop safe spaces for children and women. Blue Dots provide key information to travelling families, help to identify unaccompanied and separated children and ensure their protection.
- Continuing emergency response efforts to address the COVID-19 outbreak, including by working with municipalities to increase COVID-19 vaccination rates, and by strengthening awareness raising and capacity building efforts.

As a collective or individual participant, you will then be guided to photograph a fragment of the sky above you, and hang an anti-particulate matter filter in the space where you will spend the rest of the day so as to filter the particulate matter eventually present in the air in your environment. Participants will send their mask filter from which the carbon particles will be

extracted and transformed into an ink used to print an artistic picture of your sky. Your carbon black printed pictures as well as the creative process will be publicly exhibited.

The “Leonardo 4 Children” workshop session seek to support children and teenagers involved in addressing the issues at stake in a pro-active way.

The workshop-session will involve the children taking part in interactive activities around the fables they created on climate change and gender equality and the possible solutions they came up with in the creative process.

The children will be asked to propose their own perspective and comments on a fables which they can freely select among the winning ones (available on Facebook @Carano4Children and on the [book at this link](#)).

Please prepare a very short presentation of you work, and questions and comments in advance to ask on the winning fables made by other children.

In this way the workshops will not only raise the awareness about peace, equality and climate change but they also will promote the actual process of sharing the work and ideas of other children.
