The uniqueness of "Leonardo 4 Children" initiative lies in its being a binary process stimulating children and teenagers to use both artistic and scientific skills to express themselves and offer ways to solve key global challenges:

What can be done to solve the problems of peace, climate change or equality?

The "Leonardo 4 Children" workshop session seeks to support children and teenagers involved in addressing the issues at stake in a pro-active way.

The workshop-session will involve the children taking part in interactive activities around the fables they created on climate change and gender equality and the possible solutions they came up with in the creative process.

- Participants in Leonardo 4 Children Awards will present their works on climate, equality & peace, and highlight the learning they developed during the activity.
 Please prepare a short presentation of your work, and questions and comments in advance to ask about the winning works made by other children.
- Winners of Leonardo 4 Children Awards will present their work and their proposals
 for the Talent Development programme. It is recommended that the winners
 prepare their presentation in advance and rehearse the oral presentation with the
 teachers.

In this way the workshop will raise the awareness about peace, equality and climate change and they also will promote the actual process of sharing the work and ideas of other children.
